



ROADMAP: Nestlé Deutschland AG

Background

At the 2022 General Meeting of the German Initiative on Sustainable Cocoa (GISCO), it was decided that the preparation of individual roadmaps by each GISCO member and annual public reporting on commitments and milestones included in these roadmaps is a valuable and mandatory contribution to achieve [GISCO's objectives](#).

In addition to the monitoring and based on the [GISCO roadmap](#) which lists the goals, targeted indicators and recommendations for action of the German Initiative on Sustainable Cocoa on the focus topics of certified/independently verified cocoa, traceability, deforestation/agroforestry, child labor and living income, the members of GISCO draw up individual roadmaps on these focus topics, which are published on the GISCO website.

Member's comment on the roadmap:

Traceability

Commitment:

Full segregated traceability by 2027 - transforming the sourcing of cocoa to achieve full traceability and segregation of our cocoa products from origin to factory in the next five years.

Milestone:

Segregation for cocoa butter and identity preserved liquor in 2023 for the German confectionary factory in Hamburg. They will source cocoa from the Cocoa Plan & Income Accelerator Farms

Milestone:

Launch of the Income Accelerator Program in 2022: the program aims to tackle child labour risks by incentivizing and supporting change in the cocoa farming households and to help them towards a living income. It does this through a cash incentive and support across four areas: cocoa farm productivity, child education, agroforestry and additional incomes. Women and gender equality is a key focus. **The incentives will be paid via mobile payment to household (half to spouse).**



Challenge:

structural & political issues

Certified and independently verified cocoa

Commitment:

Worldwide: 100% Cocoa from Nestlé Cocoa Plan which is either Rainforest Alliance Certified or verified independently (LATAM) by 2025

Milestone:

Europe: 100% Cocoa from Nestlé Cocoa Plan and Rainforest Alliance Certified by end of 2022

Milestone:

Germany: 100% Cocoa from Nestlé Cocoa Plan and UTZ/ Rainforest Alliance Certified since 2016 → this commitment will go on

Challenge:

transforming the industry in Brazil

Child Labor

Commitment:

Implementation of the Income Accelerator that tackles different topics: Child labour, income gap to a living income, higher yields through good and proved agricultural practices (pruning), agroforestry, gender equivalence, transparency and traceability of payments (incentives) through direct mobile payments to farmer households and cocoa sourcing from these CocoaPlan households. The cocoa in HH will be from the households in CDI

1. Pilot-phase: 2020-2021 → 1.000 households in CDI
2. Test-phase: 2022-2023 → 10.000 households in CDI
3. Roll-out full supply chain (global, starting in Ghana) → 160.000 households
