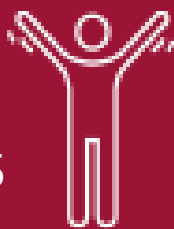

PRO-PLANTEURS in Figures

In the first phase of the project (6/2015 to 05/2020), the following results were achieved, among others:



Training

- **13,000** farmers trained in Farmer Business schools
- **18,000** farmer trained on GAP of food and vegetable crops and animal husbandry

Gender equality

- **2,000** women supported in **16** small-scale income-generating activities
- **76** women trained as rural advisors on nutrition

Nutrition and Sustainability

- **23,000** locals sensitized on good nutritional practices
- **14,000** farmers sensitized in agroforestry

Due to the success of the project it was transferred to a five-year follow-up phase. PRO-PLANTEURS II sets its focus on:

Living Income, Diversification of agricultural production, Agroforestry, Improved nutrition, Gender equality, Combatting abusive child labor
